About the Exhibition

The Pump House Regional Arts Center and the Green Bay Street Studio invite young artists to submit works for a juried, themed exhibition. Artists should submit works that employ the elements of art and principles of design as well as works that explore untamed concepts and subjects present within the natural world such as: actions, gestures, juxtapositions, instincts, animal species, and the untamed manner of living things. Artwork may be presented as representational or abstract, in media such as: sculpture, drawings, ceramics, paintings, prints, metals, and photography (with the exception of film, video, and “live art”).

About Green Bay Street Studio

Green Bay Street Studio was created to provide the La Crosse area and outlying communities with an understanding and example of contemporary art. GBSS aims to supplement and aid the education of students working and learning in La Crosse by providing a professional but accessible atmosphere that will help students of all ages understand the often mysterious and difficult world of professional art. GBSS offers workshops, critiques, figure drawing sessions, and many other opportunities for artists to share and learn.
