

CRW Tool List

These tools may be checked out to Coulee Region Woodturner members with **current** membership status, ie paid up membership. The length of tool check-out will be for 1 month, however the tool(s) may be rechecked out for an additional month if no other member desires to check them out. Tools may be checked out during regular club meetings only, as tool access is only available during meetings. It is our intent that additional tools may be added over time. The tool list will be available in the CRW library.

1. The person borrowing the tool(s) is responsible to make arrangements to return the equipment within 30 days or at the next club meeting.
2. The person using the tool(s) is responsible for tool condition on all items and must repair or replace equipment if damaged or not returned in the same condition.

Check-out process: List the tool name in the **Tool Check-out Notebook**, available in the CRW library. Include your name (please print), check out date, tool name and sign the **Tool check-out acknowledgment and process form**. When turning back in, turn in to the “tool manager, aka tool czar. When returning the tool(s), have the tool czar verify tool check-in condition and fill in the return date in the **Notebook**

This list is available in the club's library, tool items may be added over time.

- 1 Jet JWL-1015 mini lathe, 10 inch wood lathe, includes Jet live center, mini 4 prong drive center, 3" faceplate, knock out bar, no stand, approximately 80 pounds. 5 amp, 1/2 HP, 115VAC motor. The club welcomes new members without equipment to check out this lathe and the **Basic Tool Kit Bag**, see # 45 below. The basic kit will include the safety drive center. SN#1402601


