It is a wonderful experience for adults who remember doing a project or two in high school shop and a new fascination for kids to see a top turned just for them. All turned items are given away. You also will have time to turn, talk and show everyone how enjoyable turning is for you.

Turning starts at 10am and goes through out the day until evening, 7 or 8pm, according to the day and attendance. A turning space will be set up with three mini lathes, a grinder and sharpening set-up, and chucks and tools. Other helpful tools will also be on hand.



All turners are asked to bring your tools and wood for turning tops and anything you would like to turn such as small bowls, goblets, vases, etc. Extra wood will be available. Also you can bring some turned items to show and talk about with the fair-goers. People interested in learning to turn can sign up for lessons or membership in BWT.

You have not lived a full life until you have a young child watch you make her a top, then have her stand on a riser box with a set of marker pens and make your piece of wood into a rainbow work of art, with a smiling mom taking pictures of the experience.
